We are very excited that you will join us in the celebration of diversity (Cultural Art.) We have an open submission policy for artwork submitted to us during the run of the MICA Art Exhibition for three days. During the event, we will showcase Disabled and Deaf/Hard-of-Hearing Artists of all colors artwork in all mediums, including but not limited to **mixed media, video, painting, new media, digital, photography, installation, computer-oriented, or any creative mediums, etc.** If you plan to submit sculpture, please contact us.

SUBMITTING YOUR ARTWORK FOR MICA Art 2008:

If selected by a panel of reviewing judge for inclusion in an exhibition, the artist is always permitted to decline participating for any reason. If selected and you participate, all costs of the exhibition will be covered by us. This includes rental of the exhibition space, lighting, installation & de-installation, storage, cost of all printed materials (*invitations & programs*), and costs of opening receptions, etc.

If you plan to sell your artwork, we have set different prices for emerging artists, non-profit and for profit entities in return to help you promote your artwork for THREE DAYS. We will not ask for commission on any sales made during the exhibition (*regular gallery commissions are always 50%*). Because this is our first time, we are waiving the commission fee to try it out.

- Send a set of slides or prints (*we recommend 10-20 or more.*)
- Recommend a resume or brief bio about yourself
- Self-addressed stamped envelope if you want to return the slides/prints to you upon request. Please add \$5 for shipping and handling.

To submit your artwork for evaluation, prepare a packet with these materials:

- ❑ 10-20 slides marked with your name, the title, dimensions and year of the work or
- ❑ A CD Rom with images of your work. DVD accepted if presented in slideshow.

SUPPLEMENTARY MATERIALS:

* Your resume or bio, a slide list (including dimensions and mediums of each piece), an artist statement and any other information that you feel may be useful.
