We are looking for films/videos submission made by Deaf/Hard-of-Hearing and Hearing filmmakers of colors for film screening competitions showcase during the MICA Runway 2008 event. Filmmakers are encouraged to submit short films or videos no longer than 30 minutes in length, on any topic. Subject topics must be **DEAF –RELATED**. First and second place winners will receive cash and prize awards.

A panel of judges will screen and select your films for the award competition. MICA participating audiences will also be given a list of films with survey to vote for their favorite film.

All genres are welcome: animation, narrative, documentaries, drama, music videos and experimental work, etc. Not to disrespect ASL, but absolutely no boring ASL Poetry storytelling video submissions accepted for this specific showcase unless your work bears uniqueness in creativity or originality, like film, “Vital Signs” by Wayne Betts, Jr. (This is an avant-garde work of art with a story behind it, a beginning, middle and an ending.) **If you have a film story like that, I welcome you to submit. We want something out of your story.**

If you have ASL combined with abstract art medium with no story, you are encourage to submit your work for consideration under MICA Art category.

High School filmmakers welcome.

A PANEL OF FILM AND VIDEO PROFESSIONALS WILL SCREEN ALL SUBMISSIONS.
